

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Complete an application form obtained upon request from your school or by downloading it (www.julesguesde.fr) and submit it to the school no later than the date indicated on the high school's web site

Convocations will be sent to families by mail

Aptitude tests at Jules Guesde:

- **Written test:** 2h a Wednesday afternoon
- **Oral test :** 20min in May

The tests allow us to measure the capacity of French-speaking students to follow lessons dispensed in English and to evaluate the level of French of English-speaking students

ADMISSION RESULTS

After taking into consideration the student files and test results, the Principal establishes a list of accepted candidates which he submits to the Inspector of the Academy.

ADVANTAGES OF THE AMERICAN SECTION

- Allies French curriculum and foreign curricula
- Allows students regular practice of the **English language**, study of **Anglo-American literature** and deepening of their knowledge of American **history, geography** and **culture**
- Attests to a **high level of language skills** when validated by the **Baccalaureate**
- Favours access to the "**grandes écoles**" and the pursuit of **studies abroad**

FOR WHICH STUDENTS IS IT INTENDED ?

- English-speakers of all nationalities
- Bi-national or bilingual English-speakers
- French students with a **high level of English** and a **strong motivation to read literary works in**

LANGUAGE CONTENT

Weekly schedule :

- 2^{nde} : 3 hours of English
- 1^{ère} : 2,5 hours of English
- T^{le} : 2 hours of English

NB: English-speaking or bilingual students may be exempted from English lessons to take advantage of a supplementary course in French in order to facilitate their integration into the French school system



- **4** hours of **Anglo-American literature** dispensed **in English** by a teacher who is an English native speaker
- **4** hours of **History - Geography** dispensed in **English and/or French (on a 2 + 2 hour basis)**

L'OPTION OIB AU BACCALAURÉAT

The exams :

Students enrolled in an **international section** sit the **same exams** as their classmates in the same series.

However they take **specific exams** in **Anglo- American literature** and in **History - Geography**.



Anglo-American Literature exams (ES, L & S)

- **Written** composition in English

length: **4** hours coefficient: **5** in ES & S, **6** in L

- **Oral** literary commentary in English

length: **30** minutes coefficient: **4**

History-Geography exams

- **Written** composition in English

length : **4** hours coefficient : **5** in ES & L, **4** in S

- **Oral** interrogation in English

length 20min coefficient : **4** in ES, **3** in L & S
